There are two specific inquiries that are allowed in order to determine whether an animal qualifies as an emotional support animal. Please provide for our records the specific information requested below.

*What work, assistance, tasks, services or emotional support does the animal provide that alleviates one or more of the identified symptoms or effects of that person's existing and verified disability?

The individual with a disability may be asked to remove an emotional support animal from the premises if the animal is out of control and the animal's handler does not take effective action to control it. For example, an emotional support animal shall have a harness, leash, or other tether when outside.

Coral Princesse is a close residential community and as such we do expect all our residents to be respectful and mindful of the rights and needs of other residents. Excessive noise is not expected of an emotional support animal, and is very disruptive to the peace and tranquility of our close community setting.
